CASE STUDY

SOUTHEAST POLK NEW 6-7 MIDDLE SCHOOL

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Southeast Polk 6-7 Middle School is a new, approximately 210,000-square-foot, two-story facility located in Altoona, Iowa. The building includes classrooms, a gymnasium, cafeteria, library and administrative spaces that support a modern learning environment for a growing student population.

The facility is designed to reduce energy use by over 60%.

ENERGY EFFICIENCY STRATEGIES

The project incorporates energy efficiency strategies informed by energy modeling and design analysis, including:

- **High-efficiency HVAC systems**, including air-cooled chillers, gas boilers and active chilled beam systems, improving heating and cooling performance. The chilled beam systems create a quieter learning environment by reducing the need for fan-driven air movement in classrooms. It also reduces ductwork and the number of moving parts in occupied spaces, lowering maintenance costs.
- **A dedicated ventilation system** with total heat recovery, enhanced partial load efficiency and demand control ventilation, further lowering utility costs while still supporting healthy indoor air quality
- **High-efficiency lighting and controls**, including lighting power densities significantly below baseline; occupancy and vacancy sensor controls in classrooms, offices and common areas; and exterior lighting reductions to lower overall lighting load
- **Enhanced building envelope performance**, including higher insulation levels and high-performance glazing

These strategies collectively reduce overall energy consumption, peak demand and long-term operating costs.
